[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a magnetic board, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a magnetic board.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side view.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the magnetic board; and,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

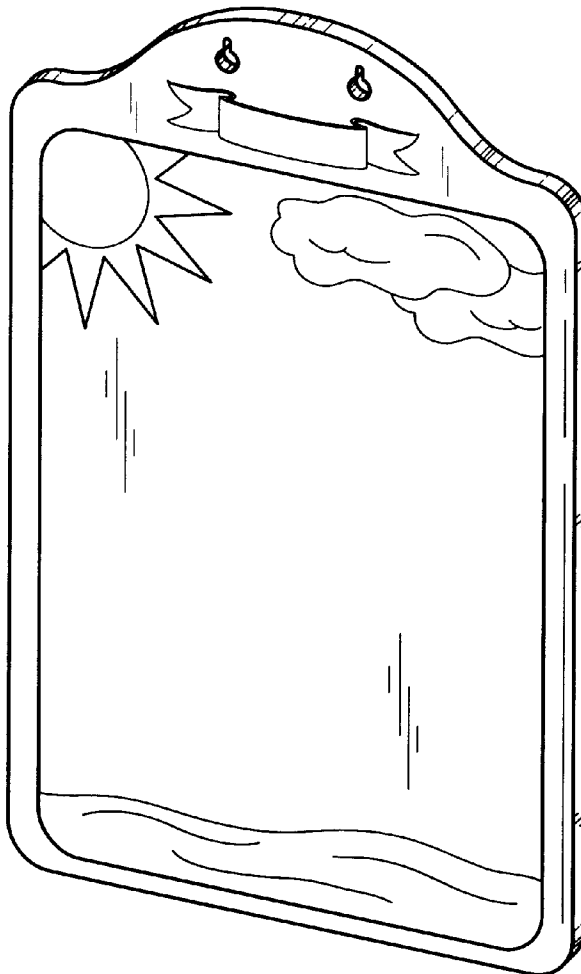

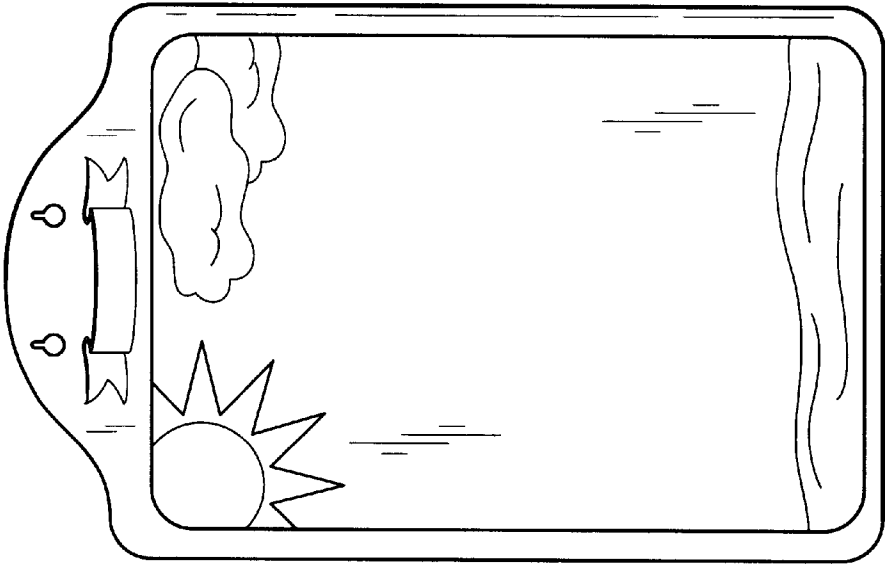

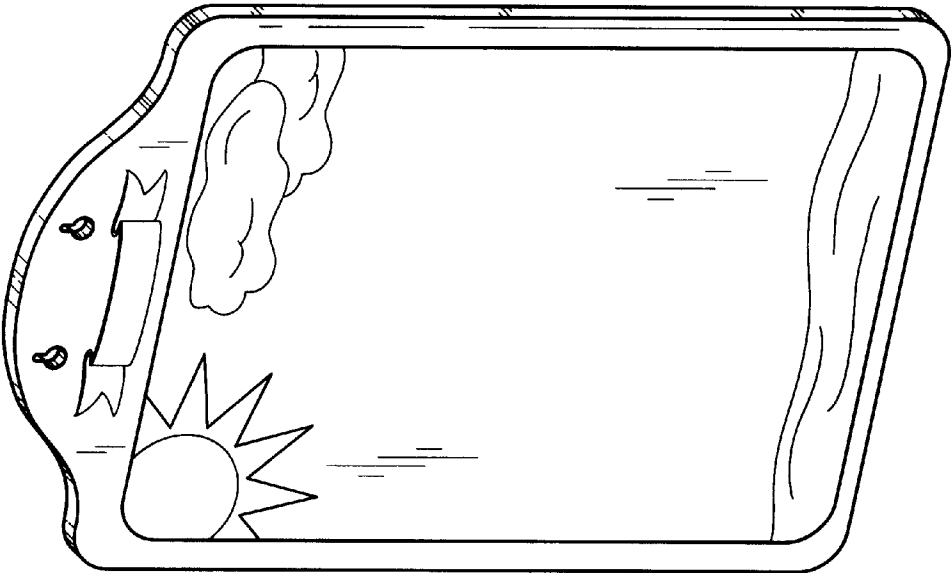

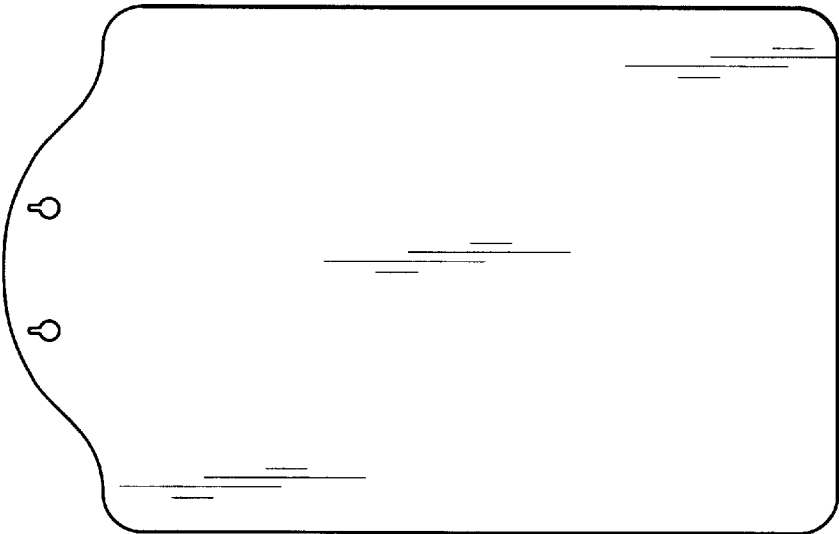
